Why study at the Universidad Europea del Atlántico

The Universidad Europea del Atlántico (UNEATLANTICO) is a higher education learning institution that offers students a well-rounded education based on academic excellence and personal commitment. Along with the specific competencies required in each area or discipline, the University guarantees that students will acquire a high level of proficiency in English, as well as cross-curricular skills in cutting-edge technology, teamwork, and project planning and management.

A university with a strong focus on internationalization

The Universidad Europea del Atlántico is strategically located in the Scientific and Technological Park of Cantabria, located in the city of Santander in the north of Spain.

The university campus occupies an area that is 16,500 square meters in size. The campus consists of a main building with five floors and underground parking. Currently, this building includes classrooms, laboratories, study rooms, a library, a cafeteria, and other multi-purpose areas. There is also an auditorium with seating for 400, a gymnasium, and other sports facilities.

The campus also houses the Industrial Research and Technological Center of Cantabria (CITICAN), a foundation that was born to channel the R&D projects of the academic institution.

The Universidad Europea del Atlántico (UNEATLANTICO) is dynamic and flexible, with the capability of adapting to student needs through personalised attention. The faculty is made up of highly-qualified teaching staff from Spain and other countries, as well as professionals, researchers and renowned academics.

Our academic program offers accredited undergraduate and postgraduate degrees, as well as unique, UNEATLANTICO-based certificates and diplomas. The University is comprised of the Faculties of Health Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities, and the Higher Polytechnic School.



Study in Spain for an international experience

The Universidad Europea del Atlántico has 35 offices throughout the world, and has numerous cooperation agreements with international businesses.

This international dimension facilitates mobility and exchanges for students, faculty, and researchers, thereby converting the Santander campus into a multicultural meeting of the minds. This translates into joint projects and research programmes that include groups of several different nationalities.

Living in Santander (Cantabria)

Santander is a city in northern Spain, belonging to the autonomous region of Cantabria, bathed by the sea and in close proximity to the mountains as well. It is a quiet and safe city with a population of approximately two hundred thousand inhabitants

It is a city with a long tradition of diverse cultural events such as art exhibits, conferences, concerts, theatre, dance, etc.

It is also a city related to the world of sports, such as football, handball, athletics, and swimming competitions. There are numerous sailing competitions on the city's bay and there is also a remarkable passion for Cantabrian bowling, a native sport of rural origin. There is also a golf course with a spectacular view of the coast. Cantabria is a seaport, yet is only an hour's drive from the highest mountain peaks reaching more than 2,000 meters of altitude. This makes the region ideal for those who wish to practice both ocean and mountain sports.

The city is well connected by highways to the neighboring cities of Bilbao, Oviedo, and Burgos, as well as by train to the capital of Spain. The Severiano Ballesteros international airport also offers numerous daily flights to Madrid, Barcelona, and some European capitals such as London or Rome.

Santander and its lifestyle are very attractive for university students because distances are short and the cost of living is less expensive than in most European countries. Easy access to all of the city's opportunities and resources makes Santander an ideal place to enjoy a study abroad experience.

Access to Undergraduate Programmes

In order to be able to enrol in an official university degree program, one of the following legal requirements must be met:

- Be in possession of a qualification that legally entitles applicants to be admitted to official university study programmes in their own country (Secondary Education, Sixth Form, university entrance exams).
- In order to be admitted using this procedure, **it will be necessary for students to apply for legal recognition of their studies**, which involves equating the relevant foreign qualification to its equivalent in Spain. This application should be made through the Embassy or Consulate located in the student's country of origin.
- Be in possession of a qualification or have followed a course of **studies that legally entitles the applicant to be admitted to official university programmes in countries belonging to the European Union** or in countries holding bilateral agreements with Spain. In these cases, applicants will be required to obtain the University Access Credential issued by the UNED (Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia).
- Hold a university degree or have previously taken university courses belonging to an official undergraduate degree or equivalent.
- Be in possession of an International Baccalaureate (IB) or European Baccalaureate (EB).
