Which courses will be recognized?

Recognized are courses of your own department, other departments of the TUM, as well as from external institutes which serve to develop your personal competency. Possible examples for recognition are language courses from the Language Center of the TUM, courses at the Carl-von-Linde Academy, Virtuelle Hochschule Bayern, etc. Due to additional competences, no performance from previous courses of study can be included.

For the course, the workload must be clearly defined, this means that credit points must be achieved. Partial performance of a module, for which no credits are awarded, cannot be recognized. Please inform yourself beforehand whether credit points are awarded (at the site where you have registered for the desired module). Furthermore, for external courses a module description must be available.

Graded or ungraded courses can both be credited. For graded performance, the grade will automatically be included in your overall average.

Under "Free Electives", you will find suggestions in the future for courses, which have already been recognized, in your curriculum (TUMonline).

How are the courses recognized?

Evidence of the courses completed (with number of credits) has to be submitted in original form (s. Application for recognition) to Ms. Beate Hufnagel during her office hours (Mon-Thur 9:15-11:15 a.m. and Tues 1:30-3:00 p.m.). The performance in an examination is then entered directly in TUMonline.

For courses of the TUM, which you can register via TUMonline, it is sufficient if you inform Ms. Hufnagel ([b-eate.hufnagel@tum.de](mailto:beate.hufnagel@tum.de)) that you would like to have these courses recognized as Free Electives.
